Talmage Boston "Baseball!"

Baseball season is just around the corner, and attorney **Talmage Boston** will share some of the essences of the game, usually considered "America's Pastime."

Talmage Boston's passion is professional baseball. He has authored a book on baseball's pivotal year, 1939, as well as four articles in *The Scribner Encyclopedia of American Lives—Sports Figures*. He has written thirty-two columns and twenty-one book reviews published in *The Dallas Morning News*, and has lectured at Princeton University.

He has also been a television and radio commentator, having appeared on "Sports Talk", "Southwest Sports Report", and "Good Morning Texas", and is a media member of the Texas Baseball Hall of Fame.

Talmage received BA and JD degrees from the University of Texas at Austin. He is a shareholder in the firm of Winstead Sechrest and Minich P.C., and is currently Officer and Director of a governing board of the State Bar of Texas. He is a Past Chairman of the Business Litigation Section of the Dallas Bar Association.

He is a Lead Counsel and has seventeen published opinions, including two in the Texas Supreme Court and one in the U.S. 5th Circuit Court of Appeals. He is one of only seventy-two lawyers in the State of Texas with double board certifications, his being Civil Trial Law and Civil Appellate Law.

Talmage lives in the Park Cities with his wife, son, and daughter, and is very active in Highland Park Methodist Church.
