A special meeting was held at the hall of State at Fair Park on October 28, 1984. The DCPA was given a tour of the Dallas Historical Society by Mr. Casey Green. We were allowed to examine original maps, letters, books, posters and other historical documents of Dallas City and County. The Dallas Historical Society specializes in the collection, preservation and use of items dating before 1900 for the City and County of Dallas and the State of Texas and their holdings are valued in excess of \$80 million. They have the largest collection of photographs of that era and area in existence. If you missed this special meeting, stop in the Hall of State sometime just to look around.

A prior president enrolled DCPA in the Dallas Heritage Council and Bill Jacoby attended one of their meetings, submitted a "Goals for Dallas" type questionnaire on the DCPA and attended a half day meeting of all associated organizations held in the Oak Lawn United Methodist Church on November 7. The DHC is a little heard of organization but has done some outstanding work in the preservation field and if it recognizes its opportunity, it can serve a much needed co-ordinating role in the preservation of Dallas historical sites, buildings or structures, and people. 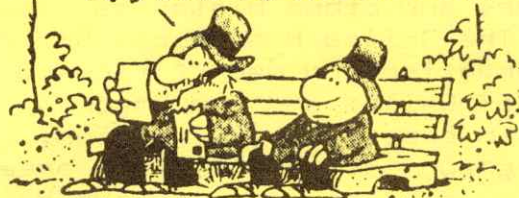

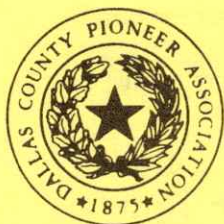
